Flag Pledges

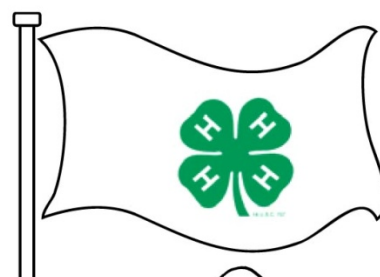
The American Flag Pledge:

(Arms at sides)



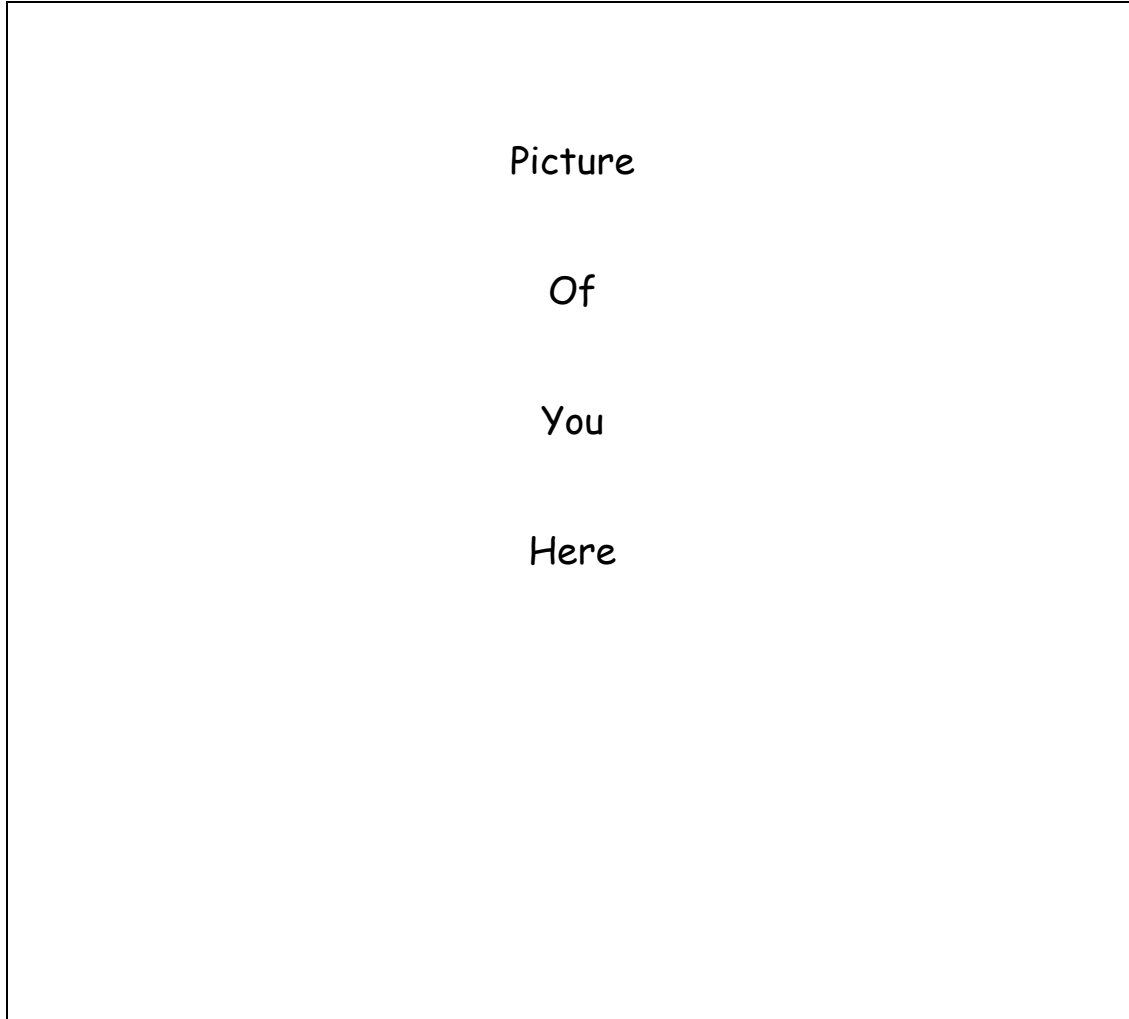
(Right hand point to forehead)
