
#### Park Visitation

Over 63% of single day visitors attended the park between four and six hours.

"Visitors" is defined as the total number of people who visited the park in a given year. This may include repeat visits throughout the year, but does not include multiple entries for a single park visit.

"Visitor-Days" is the weighted duration of the visitor number by the amount of time visitors were at the park. Someone visiting for a couple hours is weighted less than someone who spent the entire day at the park, who is, in turn, weighted less than someone who camped at the park for multiple nights.























If these amenities had been available during your last visit, how likely would you have been to use them?


