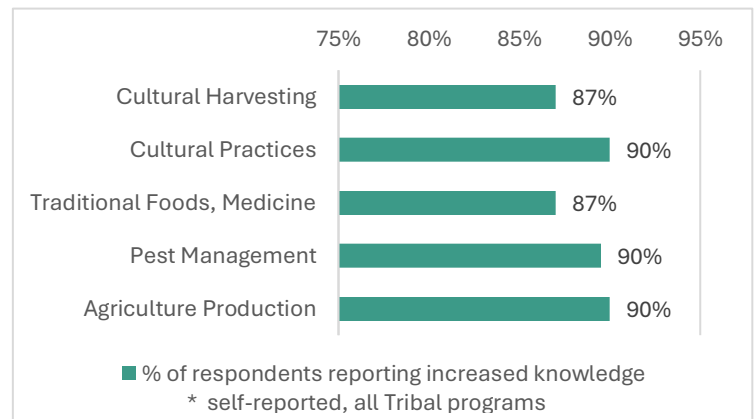


Nevada Tribal Extension Programs advanced culturally grounded education. Programming emphasized food sovereignty, native plant identification and harvesting, traditional cultural practices, and medicinal plant knowledge. Eighteen workshops, outreach events and trainings were held within Shoshone Tribal communities, reaching 310 participants and reinforcing culturally rooted learning.

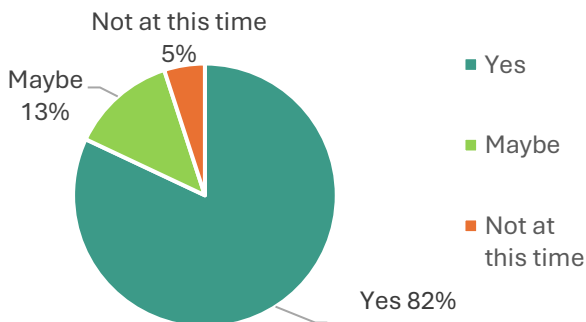
